Goal Your purpose as a C4K Mentor is to teach valuable skills, set a positive example and be a friend.

Duties After attending a Mentor Orientation session, you will be matched with one of our students. You will meet with your student once per week to work on projects that you decide upon together. You may also choose to attend special C4K-sponsored events for mentors and/or students.

Qualifications You need not be a programmer or Web designer to be a C4K Mentor. If you are comfortable using the Internet and Microsoft applications such as Excel, Word and PowerPoint, and can navigate around a Windows or Mac computer, you can teach a student a great deal. Your positive attitude and interest in learning new things will be your keys to success as a mentor.

Time Required Mentor Orientation: 2.5 hours; Meetings with student: One hour per week for 36 hours (community members); one and a half hours per week for a school year for UVa students.
